Sessions - If you would like extra hours, or wish to change days in September can you let us know as soon as possible please, as these sessions are filling up.










Tapestry - for group discussions and to promote communication and language we would love you to upload any photos on the site for us to share.



Finally –a polite reminder to please ensure your child is collected no later than 3.00 pm, as this is our closing time and there will be a late charge fee. Thank you.
